VENUE

Goris is a small beautiful town in the eastern part of the Syunik Province, south of Armenia. Located in the valley of the river Goris (also known as Vararak), it is 254 km away from the Armenian capital Yerevan and 67 km from the provincial center Kapan. Goris is an urban community and the second largest city in Syunik. Early humans settled in the area of Goris as early as in the Stone Age. The first mention of Goris goes back to the Urartian period. King Rusa I of Urartu (8th century BC) left a cuneiform, where he mentioned that "Goristsa" was among the 23 countries he had conquered. The scientists believe it was the area known today as Goris. During the Middle Ages, the town settlement was situated in the eastern part of today's Goris, on the left bank of the Goris river. It was called "Kores" and coincided with one of the villages of Goru and Goraik mentioned by Stepanos Orbelyan (13th century AD).



The Monastery of Tatev is located in South-Eastern Armenia, in the area of the ancient Armenian Syunik, not far from the town of Goris and 280 km away from Yerevan. The Tatev plateau has been in use since pre-Christian times, hosting a pagan temple. The temple was replaced with a modest church following the Christianization of Armenia in the 4th century AD.
